Any student can talk with a counselor about concerns that may be affecting his/her ability to learn and grow in the school environment.

What is a School Counselor?

- A school person that helps children.
- A resource person for teachers, parents and school administrators.
- A liaison with outside agencies and individuals.
- A coordinator.
- A consultant.
- A friend.
