WHAT IS A SCHOOL COUNSELOR?

- A school person that helps ALL children.
- A resource person for teachers, parents and school administrators.
- A liaison with outside agencies and individuals.
- A counselor.
- A coordinator.
- A consultant.
- A friend.



THE SCHOOL COUNSELOR..

- Sees children individually and in groups.
- Conducts classroom activities in self-concept and social development and career awareness through group guidance.
- Gains an understanding of a child through observation and testing.
- Uses the community as a resource.
- Conducts parent meetings.
- Works with teachers.
- Talks with parents.



A CHILD MAY SEE A COUNSELOR FOR...

- Improvement of self-concept.
- Poor or inadequate peer relationships.
- A family problem.
- A fear.
- A physical concern.
- A discussion about his/her career plans.
