Dear Parent/Guardian:

The school lunch program at Galloway Township Public Schools is dedicated to supplying a healthy and nutritious meal to your children. Our goal is to treat our customers with respect and to provide a positive experience for our customers during lunch time.

In order to succeed, we rely on the responsibility of parents and guardians to make timely payments for lunch and snack purchases. We have implemented the following charge procedures in all schools. We appreciate our customer support and will continue to strive for excellence.

- ^ **If your child arrives to school without their lunch money, the cashier will allow him/her to put their regular meal on account.**
- ^ **We can only allow up to \$25.00 to be placed on account. Beyond this point, payment must be received in a timely fashion. If payment is not received a Cheese Sandwich will be given to your child and charges will continue to be put on his/her account.**
- ^ **Snacks are on a pre-paid or cash only basis. We do not allow snacks to be put on account at any time.**
- ^ **Eighth grade account balances will not be refunded at the end of the school year. The cafeteria manager will notify parents/guardians in the month of April, of any positive or negative account balances. Negative balances must be paid by the end of the school year. All other account balances must be used up by the end of the school year, or parents/guardians may request positive balances be transferred to siblings in the school district.**
- ^ **The Absegami High School is not linked with PCS and the PayPams program, therefore balances are not carried over when your children graduate eighth grade.**

We would appreciate all account balances be current. Please feel free to contact your child's school cafeteria manager if you have a question concerning their account balance. You will receive a weekly letter from the cafeteria manager when your child has a negative balance on his/her account. Please avoid this by ensuring your account does not go negative.
